
DESCRIPTION OF THE SITUATION(S)/EVENTS

Last year the toolbox "**Safe storage and racking**" was discussed. Despite this attention, we have recently received several reports related to unsafe situations in storage and the movement of materials.

- Employee wanted to remove stacks of wood from the bulk stock, due to a combination of several factors, part of the stacked pile of wood behind the pile he picked from fell against a parked truck.
- Employee hit the pallet with the forks of his forklift, causing the pallet to fall between the racks
- When moving the stock, the forks are pushed against a piece of wood lying in between (across) the stacks, pushing the stack over on the other side.

Fortunately, it was only material damage, but these reports could have led to serious injury. We work safely together. Prevent incidents and stay alert!

WHAT MEASURES CAN WE TAKE TO PREVENT A RECURRENCE OF THIS INCIDENT?

- Work according to the applicable procedures and instructions
- Repeat the "Secure Storage and Racking" toolbox
- Always report an unsafe situation and take immediate measures.
- Check whether this situation also occurs in your location and, if necessary, take measures to ensure safety

Ask these three questions:

1. Can this accident be prevented at our location?
2. What systems are in place to prevent this type of accident at our site?
3. -Are these systems actually applied?
