DESCRIPTION OF THE SITUATION(S)/EVENTS

During our daily work, we regularly work with materials where there is a risk of cutting. From packaging material, straps to products with sharp edges. (Also read: Safety alert 08-2025)

In the past period we had to deal with several cutting incidents at different locations and with every incident it became clear that the prescribed personal protective equipment (PPE) were not used (correctly)

Wearing the right PPE is important because it significantly reduces the risk of serious injuries. PPE is not optional; it is an essential part of working safe.

In short:

- Check that you have all the necessary PPE with you or are present at the workplace.
- Are your PPE in good condition! In case of wear and tear or lack of the right PPE, ask for new ones right away!

And just as important, talk to each other when the proper PPE are not used or used incorrectly. So, keep talking to your teams about safety, this is and remains extremely important.

WHAT MEASURES CAN WE TAKE TO PREVENT A RECURRENCE OF THIS INCIDENT?

- Always use prescribed/mandatory personal protective equipment (PPE) in the right situations.
- You are responsible for maintaining your PPE, regularly check for damage and/or breakage and ask for replacement where necessary.
- Always report an unsafe situation (if possible, via the Compass app) and take immediate measures.
- Check whether this situation also occurs in your location and, if necessary, take measures to ensure safety

Ask these three questions:

1. Can this accident be prevented at our location?
2. What systems are in place to prevent this type of accident at our site?
3. Are these systems applied?
